



Frequently Asked Questions

1. How can tickets be purchased?
 - a. London Health Sciences Centre employees who are able to enroll in payroll deduction can purchase tickets by completing the online form at <https://apps.lhsc.on.ca/?q=forms/lhsc-staff-lottery>
2. What are the Payday Plus ticket prices?
 - a. \$3 per ticket
3. Is there a limit to the number of tickets I can purchase?
 - a. No
4. How old do you have to be to purchase a ticket?
 - a. Participants must be 18 years of age or older.
5. When are the draws? Where?
 - a. Draws will be held on the Friday of every payday at 10:00 a.m., draws will take place at the London Health Sciences Foundation Office, located at 747 Base Line Rd., East, London, ON.

6. How many tickets are sold in total?
 - a. There will be a total of 7,000 tickets available for purchase.
7. What is the value of the prize payout that will be won?
 - a. The actual prize amount varies with participation to a maximum of \$10,500 per draw. Fifty percent of all monies received for each bi-weekly draw will be awarded to the winner. The other fifty percent of all monies will be used towards London Health Sciences Centre's highest priority needs, included equipment, research and improving patient care.
8. What if the lottery is sold out?
 - a. Names will be placed on a waiting list. If a spot becomes available, the ticket will be reassigned to the next person on the list in the order in which their enrolment form was received.
9. What methods of payment are accepted?
 - a. Payroll deduction is the only form of payment accepted at this time.
10. How much will be deducted from my paycheque?
 - a. Deductions are dependent on the number of tickets you purchase. Tickets are \$3 per ticket. For example: If you select 3 tickets \$9 will be deducted each pay period and 3 tickets will be entered into the draw each pay period.
11. When will my paycheque start getting deducted?
 - a. If you sign up before February 21st, your first deduction will be on March 6th.
 - b. After the first cut-off, deductions will begin on the next available pay period.
12. Who is eligible to purchase tickets?
 - a. LHSC employees on payroll that are able to enroll in payroll deduction can participate.
13. Is anyone excluded from participating?
 - a. Alcohol and Gaming Commission regulations prohibit the following persons and their immediate families residing in the same household from purchasing a ticket: Employees of London Health Sciences Foundation and Children's Health Foundation.
14. How do I opt out of the payroll deduction program?
 - a. You can cancel your participation in the staff lottery at any time; simply notify London Health Sciences Foundation in writing by email to stafflottery@lhsc.on.ca or calling the Foundation Office at 519-685-8812. Cancellations must be received two weeks prior to

the draw date. To resume play, individuals will be added to the bottom of the waiting list and will be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis, as tickets become available.

15. How do I receive my ticket?

- a. Your ticket number(s) will be emailed to the email address provided during sign up.

16. Is the ticket tax deductible/do you get a tax receipt?

- a. Unfortunately, lottery ticket purchases are non-recipientable, as per CRA guidelines.

17. Where do proceeds from the Payday Plus lottery go?

- a. Proceeds will support London Health Sciences Centre's priorities needs, including equipment, research and improving patient care,

18. How many names can be put on a ticket?

- a. Only one name will be listed on a ticket. Group purchases are permitted; however members must work out the details of payment and payout amongst themselves. The winning prize, in the case of a group purchase, will be issued in the name of the ticket holder.

19. How are winners notified?

- a. Winners will be notified by phone and/or email that they have won within 48 hours of the draw.
- b. Winners name and ticket number will be posted on the Payday Plus 50/50 website at www.lhsf.ca/paydayplus. Winner may also be announced on the London Health Sciences Centre's intranet when possible. The winner must present a photo identification card upon delivery of their prize.
