


About LHSC

London Health Sciences Centre (LHSC) is one of Canada's largest acute care teaching hospitals. Located in London, Ontario, LHSC is a multi-site facility that encompasses University Hospital, Victoria Hospital, Children's Hospital, the Westmount Kidney Care Centre, Byron and Victoria Family Medical Centres, and the 54 Riverview Avenue site. In addition, LHSC is the home of Lawson Health Research Institute, Children's Health Research Institute, CSTAR (Canadian Surgical Technologies & Advanced Robotics), Fowler Kennedy Sport Medicine Clinic, as well as Children's Health Foundation and London Health Sciences Foundation.

LHSC is a leading academic health organization committed to collaborating with patients, families and system partners to deliver excellent care experiences and outcomes, educate the health-care providers of tomorrow, and advance new discoveries and innovations that optimize the health and wellbeing of those we serve.

Part of a system: Load-leveling across critical care centres

LHSC played an important role in the pandemic response in April 2021 as part of the provincial Critical Care System in ensuring critical care remained available to Canadians who needed it through load levelling support efforts.
