ABOUT THE EVENT

The **London Run for Ovarian Cancer** was started 20 years ago by a small grass roots group in support of their friend who had developed ovarian cancer. This event generates the largest amount of funding for London Health Sciences Centre (LHSC) of any peer-to-peer fundraising event in London.

Thousands of women across Canada are living with ovarian cancer. Lack of reliable early detection tests and few treatment options mean many women are at stage three and four by the time they are diagnosed and, as a result, 70 per cent will die because of the disease.

Funds raised by the London Run for Ovarian Cancer provide the Translational Ovarian Cancer Research Unit at LHSC with necessary resources to help establish new collaborations with researchers across Canada to develop new ways to kill ovarian cancer cells.

THE OPPORTUNITY
